If you were elected on or before April 26, 2018 you will not be eligible to attend the 2019 Spring Fellowship and Induction Weekend. If you do not complete your ordeal and your one year of eligibility has expired your name may be placed on a OA Troop election ballot again if you meet the eligibility requirements at the time of the new election. Adult nominations for troop adults are also subject to one year of eligibility. Nominations should be submitted at the same time as the Troop election and even if submitted after the election they are subject to the one year of eligibility relative to the date of the Troop election.
